participants came from all over the nation and from different institutions and clubs. Team UNIMAS was represented by Dr Abdul Riezal Dim, Aliffazraie Jali and Fitzpatrick Ricky. The facilitators consisted of film documentaries enthusiasts and former television production crew such as En Zaki Abd Rahim, En Jamil Mutalib, Dr Kamarudzaman Md Isa and Cikgu Abd Karim Ahmad. Some highlight of the trip is the 'floating classroom' since the workshop was conducted on a huge boathouse moving from the jetty towards the middle of Tasik Temenggor where we witnessed the grand forest reserve that is believed to have existed for 130 million years thus one of the oldest in the world.

The class went on for 2 days until we arrived in a safe spot to dock the boat when pre-production commences. For the next 2 days, the workshop shifted into the production and post-production phases while the participants were escorted to some

places of interest by the organisers. Some noteworthy locations in Tasik Temenggor are Lang Mountain (named after the discoverer, Pak Lang) Pulau Batu Putih (White Rock Island), rafflesia blooms and 'salt lick' for the wild elephants. Future visitors are highly recommended to bring along hiking gear since all the interesting places are situated within an island thus the trails are slippery and tricky while some are infested with leeches and elephant dung.

On the final day, participants were transported back to the starting point and at the same time, the output videos were screened by the organisers, and everyone discussed ways to improve documentaries. This the Nature **Documentary Production Workshop 2.0** is worthy to be a must-go event for film documentaries lovers since participants will be exposed to the theories of filmmaking to production including workshops on shooting with camera and footage editing




